The FA-PAC Internship Program gives students the practical, hands-on training and experience needed to be effective organizers. It provides students the opportunity to engage in advocacy, community organizing, elections/campaigns, and public policy advocacy. Students broaden their horizons and learn by doing. Students also develop social networks, on campus and beyond. In addition, students are paid for their work, which benefits them directly.

9. How do you use other funding to support your program? The FA-PAC provides stipends for faculty mentors and pays the hourly wages of the intern coordinator.

10. What would be the impact if DASG did not completely fund this request? If DASG did not completely fund this request, the FA-PAC Internship program would have less of an impact on election organizing work, including classroom presentations, voter registration, education, and mobilization, and informational events.
