- Total resident and non-resident FTES decreased 5% from 6,111 to 5,834.
- Resident FTES is down 5% from 5,235 to 4,968, and non-resident FTES is down 1% from 876 to 866.

### Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment Categories

- Within the resident category, total enrollment of AB540 students decreased 17% from 2,574 to 2,138.
- Within the non-resident category, enrollment of students from another country (with or without an educational visa) decreased 6% from 7,382 to 6,904.

### International Students

- International students with an F1 or FZ visa status enrolled in fall is at 1,905, down from 2,090 students from last fall.
- Females comprise 46% of the international students with F1 or FZ visa status.
- Top countries of origin for F1 or FZ international students includes: China, Vietnam, South Korea, Japan and Taiwan.

- Continuing student headcount decreased 5% from 12,956 to 12,258 and FTES decreased 6%.
- Returning student headcount increased 6% from 3,071 to 3,048 and FTES increased 3%.
- High school student enrollment increased 6% from 221 to 234.
