Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment Categories

- Within the resident category, total enrollment of AB540 students decreased 2% from 710 to 694 while FTES decreased 4% from 69 to 66.
- Within the non-resident category, enrollment of students from another country (with or without an educational visa) decreased 8% from 1,918 to 1,768 while FTES decreased 8% from 197 to 182.

International Students

- International students with F1 or FZ visa status headcount is at 890, down from 969 last summer, an 8% change from summer to summer.
- Females comprise 47% of the international students with F1 or FZ visa status.
- Top countries of origin for F1 or FZ international students includes: China, Japan, Taiwan, South Korea, Vietnam, and Indonesia.

- Filipino headcount decreased 11% from 699 to 619 while FTES decreased 15% from 109 to 93.

Student Type

- First-time student headcount increased 22% from 586 to 715 and FTES increased 34% from 76 to 102.
- First-time transfer student headcount decreased 9% from 2,049 to 1,862 while FTES decreased 8% from 285 to 262.
- Continuing student headcount decreased 6% from 6,894 to 6,471 and FTES decreased 11% from 1,200 to 1,064.
- Returning student headcount decreased 1% from 1,480 to 1,467 and FTES increased 1% from 203 to 206.
- High school student enrollment increased 1% from 530 to 533 and FTES increased 2% from 59 to 60.

- As a percentage of total headcount, students from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga increased 1% at 25% of total headcount enrollment.
- Headcount from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto decreased 1% at 47% of total headcount.
- Headcount from San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, and Campbell decreased 1 percentage point at 21% of total enrollment.

Zip Code Groupings – By Ethnicity

- African American headcount from the Cupertino area increased 8% while African American headcount decreased by 8% in the San Jose East of 880 area and by 11% in the San Jose Other area.

- Filipino headcount decreased 5% in the Cupertino area, decreased 9% in the San Jose East of 880 area and decreased 22% in the San Jose Other area.
- Latino/a headcount decreased 3% in the Cupertino and San Jose East of 880 areas but increased 2% in the San Jose East of 880 area and increased by 4% in the San Jose Other area.
