Subject: Guided Pathways Village Center Demographics, Winter 2025

#### Overview:

Guided Pathways Village Centers consist of the following meta majors: Artistic Expression (AE), Business and Finance (BF), Health and Life Science (HLS), Language and Communication (LC), Physical Sciences and Technology (PST), and Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH). This report provides an overview of the headcounts, visits and demographics of those who visited a Village Center during winter 2025 quarter.

## Methodology:

The data was retrieved from SARS and provided by the Guided Pathways core team leads to Institutional Research, Planning and Accreditation. All Village Center visitors' cwids were matched to Banner and assessed to determine whether they enrolled in winter 2025 quarter. Additionally, their meta major assignment was compared to the Village Center(s) they visited.

### **Summary:**

### Most Visited Village Center

- There was a total of 938 unique cwids and a total of 1,546 visits. PST and LC Village Centers accounted for most of the headcounts and visits. Users of the Village Center were likely to visit 1 time.
- The top three reasons for visiting a Village Center were (1) to relax, (2) participate in an independent/group study session and (3) attend a workshop/event.
- Independent/group study, relaxing, office hours, staff village and workshop/event activities were mostly accessed in the PST and LC Villages.
- Counseling was mostly accessed in the BF and LC Villages.
- Support Services was mostly accessed in the LC and AE Villages.

## Enrollment and Meta Major Village vs. Village Center Visited

- While the majority of those who used a Village Center were enrolled, some were not.
  - 87% (HC=816) enrolled and had a major on file
  - 12% (HC=111) were not enrolled but had a major on file
  - 1% (HC=11) were not enrolled and did not have a major on file

• When examining students' meta major assignment to the Village Center they visited, some students utilized the Village Center associated with their meta major but most of them visited other Village Centers.

## Demographics

- Village Centers visitors skewed younger than their winter 2025 student population. This finding was consistent when examined by Village.
- Female visitors were underrepresented when compared to their winter 2025 population, 46% vs. 49%. HLS, LC and SSH consisted of fewer female visitors than their representation in the meta majors.
- Latinx and white Village Center visitors were underrepresented by 6 and 2 percentage points, respectively.
- Latinx visitors were underrepresented in AE, BF, HLS and SSH Village Centers than their representation in the meta majors.
- White visitors were underrepresented in AE, BF, LC and SSH Village Centers than their representation in the meta majors.
- Continuing students were overrepresented by 17 percentage points. High school students visited the Villages, representing 2% of visitors compared to their student population of 0.1% in winter 2025.
- First-time transfer and returning students were underrepresented in the Village Center visits.

### A. Most Visited Village Center

- PST and LC Village Centers had the most visits in winter 2025.
- Each Village Center was visited mostly one time. While the frequency of visits ranged on the lower end (1x-2x), there were higher frequency visits of 6 or more times, too.

Table 3 displays the Village Center that was most accessed by reason.

- Counseling was mostly accessed in the BF (33%) and LC (25%) Villages.
- Independent/Group Study was accessed in the PST (40%) and LC (26%) Villages.
- Just Relaxing was accessed in the LC (25%) and PST (22%) Villages.
- Office Hours was accessed in the PST (36%) and LC (35%) Villages.
- Staff Village was accessed in the PST (27%) and LC (21%) Villages.
- Support Services was accessed in the LC (46%) and AE (23%) Villages.
- Workshop/Event was accessed in the PST (29%) and LC (28%) Villages.

## B. Enrollment and Meta Major Village vs. Village Center Visited

- Among the 938 unique cwids, 87% enrolled in winter 2025 and had a major on file.
- Another 12% were not enrolled but had a major on file, and the remaining 1% neither enrolled nor had a major on file.

Table 5 compares students' major on file (and associated meta major) to the Village Center they visited. Overall, students utilized the Village Center associated with their meta major in addition to other Village Centers. A majority of LC meta majors used their LC Village, whereas HLS meta majors were likely to use the PST and LC Village Centers.

- Meta major AE students mostly visited AE (35%) and LC (34%) Village Centers.
- *Meta major BF* students mostly visited BF (31%) and LC (27%) Village Centers.
- Meta major HLS students mostly visited PST (32%) and LC (25%) Village Centers.
- *Meta major LC* students mostly visited LC (67%) Village Center.
- Meta major PST students mostly visited PST (43%) and LC (20%) Village Centers.
- Meta major SSH students mostly visited LC (31%) and SSH (25%) Village Centers.
- Students with a major on file with no meta major assignment, reflecting undecided or undeclared, personal interest, high school student, transfer studies, IGETC and GE breadth, mostly visited PST (32%) and LC (26%) Village Centers.

- There were fewer male visitors in AE and PST than compared to their representation in the meta major.

- White visitors were underrepresented in AE, BF, LC and SSH Village Centers.
